Identity of the pest:	Rhagoletis completa
Categorization of the pest:	The pest is listed in Annex I A I of Directive 2000/29/EC.
Host plants concerned:	Juglans sp.
Location:	in Magdeburg in Saxony-Anhalt

Short description:

- Date of finding: 7 October 2013
- **General context of the pest report:** Rhagoletis completa has been found on Juglans in a private garden. Rotten fruits with larvae were brought to the plant protection service. The larvae were reared and an adult was identified morphologically on 10th January 2014. The origin of the pest is unclear. The owner of the garden informed about similar symptoms on the fruits in 2012.
- Are official control measures being taken? The fruits have been destroyed and further measures are being considered.
