Pest report from NPPO of Germany

Reason for reporting: Finding of a pest in a new area

Identity of the pest:	<i>Rhagoletis completa</i>

Categorization of the pest: The pest is listed in Annex I A I of Directive 2000/29/EC.

Host plants concerned: *Juglans regia*

Location: in Berlin

Short description:

- **Date of finding:** 4th August 2014
- **General context of the pest report:** *Rhagoletis completa* has been found on *Juglans nigra* near a trial field of the Julius Kühn-Institute in Berlin. The fruits were rotten and larvae were detected inside. In addition, one specimen was caught in a yellow sticky trap that was placed for a survey. The adult was identified morphologically. The origin of the pest is unclear.
- **Are official control measures being taken?** The destruction of the fruits has been recommended and the survey will be continued.
