Directive D-97-05 describes the requirements for importation from all countries of *Chrysanthemum* spp. (species), *Dendranthema* spp. (species) and *Leucanthemella serotina* plant material, including *Dendranthema grandiflora*, the common chrysanthemums grown and used by the floricultural industry.

Under the Canada-United States Regulatory Cooperation Council (RCC) Initiative, the Canadian Food Inspection Agency and the United States Department of Agriculture are working together on a pilot project that focuses on the coordination of approaches to regulatory oversight with an emphasis on chrysanthemum white rust regulations. As a result of this pilot project, the regulatory status of chrysanthemum white rust in Canada is under review.

Once the review is completed, including stakeholder consultations, D-97-05 will be updated to reflect any changes, as appropriate. Until this review is completed, the requirements in the current version of D-97-05 (1st revision, dated September 29, 2004) remain in effect.
