- **General context of the pest report:** In the framework of the monitoring program two specimen of the Western corn rootworm were caught in a pheromone trap in a maize field near Fußgönheim. On 23rd September 2013 after the definition of the zones according to the Decision 2003/766/EC four more specimens were caught in a pheromone trap in the safety zone. In addition, one specimen of *Diabrotica virgifera virgifera* was caught in a maize field near Waldsee.
