Pest report from NPPO of Germany

Reason for reporting: Finding of a pest in a quarantine zone in Germany

Identity of the pest:	<i>Anoplophora glabripennis</i>

Categorization of the pest: listed in Directive 2000/29/EC Annex IAI a) 4.1

Host plants concerned: *Acer* sp.

Location: Bonn in North Rhine-Westphalia

Short description:

- **Date of finding:** 8th June 2012
- **General context of the pest report:** One male beetle and one larva of *Anoplophora glabripennis* have been found on an *Acer* tree at the roadside in the quarantine zone that had been established in 2009. Also other pests (*Saperda carcharias*, *Cerambyx scopolii*) were found on the tree.
- **Are official control measures being taken?** Yes, the infested tree has been eradicated and the quarantine zone has been extended. Further measures are in the process of being clarified.
