Location:	in Saxony

Short description:

- Date of finding: 18th August 2014
- **General context of the pest report:** Apple trees in a research institution showed defoliation, leave spots and yellowing on single branches or the entire crown. Single patches in a lot of 2500 trees showed these symptoms. The pathogen *Diplocarpon mali* was identified morphologically.

The origin of the disease is unknown.

- Are official control measures being taken? The fallen leaves are destroyed and the research institution was advised to spray fungicides.
