Fruits	Not more than 6 kg	NR	NR	Required
Vegetables	Not more than 6 kg	NR	NR	Required
Spices	Not more than 6 kg	NR	NR	Required
Legumes	Not more than 6 kg	NR	NR	Required
Cereals	Not more than 6 kg	NR	NR	Required
Tubers (potato, taro, etc)	Not more than 6 kg	NR	NR	Required
Rhizomes (ginger, turmeric, etc)	Not more than 6 kg	NR	NR	Required
Flower Bouquet	1 Bouquet	NR	NR	Required
Plant Products (banana leaf, nyirik leaf, etc)	Not more than 6 kg	NR	NR	Required

Personal Concession For Imported Animal Feed

Quantity allowance for each category of animal feed

Types of Animal Feed	Maximum Quantity (per person)
Processed chicken / livestock feed (pellets)	Not more than 11 kg
Pet food (dried and processed only)	Not more than 11 kg
