### **Ordinance SDA/MAPA No 1529 of 16<sup>th</sup> January 2026 establishing the phytosanitary requirements for the importation of seeds and in vitro seedlings of *Fragaria* spp. from any origin**

#### **ORDINANCE SDA/MAPA Nº 1529, of 16 January, 2026**

#### **Establishes the phytosanitary requirements for the importation of seeds and in vitro seedlings of *Fragaria* spp. from any origin**

THE SECRETARY OF AGRICULTURAL PROTECTION, OF THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE AND LIVESTOCK, in the use of the attributions conferred on it by arts. 23 and 48 of Annex I of Decree No. 12.642, of October 1, 2025, in view of the provisions of Decree No. 24,114, of April 12, 1934, in Decree No. 1,355, of December 30, 1994, in Decree No. 5,759, of April 17, 2006, in MAPA Ordinance No. 65, of March 30, 2021, in Normative Instruction No. 25, of April 7, 2020, and what is contained in Process No. 21000.008592/2025-44, resolves:

Art. 1 The phytosanitary requirements for the importation of seeds and in vitro seedlings (Category 4) of *Fragaria* spp. from any origin are established.

Sole paragraph. This Ordinance does not apply to in vitro seedlings of *Fragaria* x *ananassa* from Mercosur countries.

Art. 2 *Fragaria* spp. in vitro seedlings must be accompanied by a Phytosanitary Certificate, issued by the National Plant Protection Organization - NPPO of the country of origin, with the following Additional Declarations:

- I) "The consignment is free from *Candidatus* Phytoplasma australiense, *Candidatus* Phytoplasma solani (16SrXII-A), Crinivirus palidofragariae, Crinivirus pseudobetae, *Erwinia amylovora*, *Erwinia pyrifoliae*, *Idaeovirus rubi*, *Ilarvirus SNSV*, *Nepovirus arabis*, *Nepovirus lycopersici*, *Nepovirus nigranuli*, *Nepovirus rubi* and *Stralarivirus fragariae*, according to the result of the official laboratory analysis No ( )" or "In vitro seedlings are derived from mother plants that have been analyzed and tested and found to be free from *Candidatus* Phytoplasma australiense, *Candidatus* Phytoplasma solani (16SrXII- A), Crinivirus palidofragariae, Crinivirus pseudobetae, *Erwinia amylovora*, *Erwinia pyrifoliae*, *Idaeovirus rubi*, *Ilarvirus SNSV*, *Nepovirus arabis*, *Nepovirus lycopersici*, *Nepovirus nigranuli*, *Nepovirus rubi* and *Stralarivirus fragariae*."

Art. 3 *Fragaria* spp. seeds must be accompanied by a Phytosanitary Certificate, issued by the National Plant Protection Organization - NPPO of the country of origin, with the following Additional Declaration:

- I) "The consignment is free from *Alternaria gaisen*, *Colletotrichum godetiae*, *Erwinia amylovora*, *Erwinia pyrifoliae*, *Idaeovirus rubi*, *Ilarvirus SNSV*, *Nepovirus arabis*, *Nepovirus lycopersici*, *Nepovirus nigranuli*, *Nepovirus rubi* and *Stralarivirus fragariae*, according to the result of the official laboratory analysis No ( )".

Art. 4 According to the phytosanitary status in its territory, the country of origin may, alternatively, declare for the regulated pests above:

- I) "(Name of pest/s) is an absent quarantine pest for (country of origin)."; or  
II) "(Name of pest/s) is not present (country of origin)."

Art. 5 The country of origin must previously communicate, for approval by the NPPO of Brasil, the Additional Declaration that will be used in the issuance of the Phytosanitary Certificate.

§ 1 If there is no prior communication and approval provided for in the caput of this article, the country of origin must comply with the provisions of art. 2 and 3, being unable to use the alternative declarations provided for in art. 4.

§ 2 The country of origin must inform the change in the phytosanitary status of the indicated pests, when there is a change in the status in its territory.

Art. 6 The consignments are subject to inspection at the point of entry (Phytosanitary Inspection), as well as the collection of samples for phytosanitary analysis in official laboratories or laboratories accredited by the Ministry of Agriculture and Livestock.

§ 1 The costs of sending the samples and the phytosanitary analysis will be borne by the interested party.

§ 2 At the inspection's discretion, the interested party may remain as the depositary of the remainder of the consignment until the inspection process is completed.

Art. 7 In the event of interception of a quarantine pest or a pest that presents quarantine potential for Brazil, the consignment will be destroyed or rejected and the National Plant Protection Organization - NPPO in the country of origin will be notified.

Sole paragraph. In case of a situation described in the caput of this Article the National Plant Protection Organization - NPPO in Brazil may suspend imports of seeds and in vitro seedlings of *Fragaria* spp. until the review of the Pest Risk Analysis - PRA.

Art. 8 The consignment will not be internalized when it fails to comply with the requirements established in this Ordinance.

§ 1 For *Fragaria vesca* seeds from Germany, China, France and the Netherlands, a period of 180 (one hundred and eighty) days<sup>1</sup> is granted for the National Phytosanitary Protection Organization - NPPO of the country of origin to adapt their procedure to apply the requirements set out in this Ordinance.

§ 2 During the period provided for in § 1, the requirements in force at the time of entry into force of this Ordinance apply.

Art. 9 This Ordinance enters into force on the date of its publication.
