Note: 1. This catalog categorizes invasive species into four groups, with each group arranged in alphabetical order based on the initial letters of their scientific names.

2. The General Administration of Customs, in collaboration with relevant departments, conducts dynamic adjustments to the list based on port seizures, risk assessments, and intrusion trend analyses.

3. In addition to the aforementioned species, key port controls shall be implemented concurrently for species listed in the Catalogue of Key Managed Invasive Alien Species.
