In exercise of the powers conferred under section 27 , subsection (a) of the Plant Pest Quarantine Law , the Ministry of Agriculture and Irrigation with the approval of the Government hereby prescribes the following regulation :-

CHAPTER I

Title and Definitions

- 1. This regulation shall be called Plant Pest Quarantine Regulation .
- 2. The expressions contained in this regulation shall have the same meanings as are assigned to them in the Plant Pest Quarantine Law . In addition the following expressions shall have the meanings given hereunder :-
 - (a) Law means the Plant Pest Quarantine Law ;
 - (b) Post-entry Quarantine station means the designated station holding plant or propagative part for the purpose of conducting interceptions , research works , inspection after importation .
 - Quarantine station means designated station for the purpose of conducting inspection, withhold, disinfestation or disinfection of pests, re-exportation or destroying the plant, pest, consignment and soil when such things were imported or exported or entered as transit .
 - (d) Entry point means a designated point consignments are to be imported or exported .

CHAPTER II

Prescribing Conditions for importation

3. A person desirous of importation from abroad plant, plant product, non-plant product, pest, beneficial organism or soil shall apply to the Managing Director on $form\ 1$.



4. The Managing Director after seeking advices from the Inspector General on application made under section 3 may make any decision hereunder:-

(a) (i) Granting or refusing importation .

(ii) Passing any other order as may be deemed fit .(b) If the importation is granted, issuing the certificate of import on form 2.

(c) Prescribing one of the following conditions when imporattion is granted.

(i) Limitation of quantity or weight to be imported .
(ii) Being inspected at the post-entry quarantine station or grown or reared under supervision of the Myanma

Agriculture Service .

(iii) If the importation is for research purpose, laying down the conditions and procedures to be followed .

(iv) Prescribing any suitable conditions .

5. Plant, plant product, non-plant product, pest, beneficial organism, soil etc when entering from abroad, potential risk which can be harmful to the agricultural and forest resources, shall have to be undergone the inspection by Inspector General or Inspector.



CHAPTER III

Prescribing conditions for Exportation

- 6. A person desirous of exporting or re-exporting plant, plant product, in accordance with the requirements by importing countries shall apply to obtain phytosanitary certificate or phytosanitary certificate for re-export on ${\tt form}\ 3$.
- 7. Phytosanitary certificate can be applied only for the plant or plant product which are grown or produced in Myanmar. When re-exporting plant or plant product which are grown or produced in abroad shall apply for phytosanitary certificate for re-export along with the phytosanitary certificate issued by the country of origin.
- 8. Inspector General may assign any inspector and based on the inspection results with respect to the application made under clause 6 may grant or refuse phytosanitary certificate or phytosanitary certificate for re-export .
- 9. The Inspector General shall upon decision to grant phytosanitary certificate with respect to the application made under clause 6 shall assign any inspector to issue the phytosanitary certificate on form 4 and phytosanitary certificate for re-export on form 5.
- 10. With respect to the requirements of foreign country, when plant and plant products have to be exported or re-exported, application shall

be made to obtain the fumigation certificate to the Inspector General on form 6 .

- 11. The Inspector General with respect to the application made under clause 10 shall assign any inspector to supervise the fumigation work and shall issue the certificate of Fumigation on form 7.
- 15. The organizations recognized by the Pesticide Registration Board , when conducting fumigation may do so themselves by following the prescribed conditions .

CHAPTER IV

Undertaking duties and responsibilities by the Managing Director

- 13. The Managing Director shall :-
 - (a) Prescribe sampling techniques for the phytosanitary inspection; validity of phytosanitary certificate; the methods of inspection, forms to be used with, when the inspector General and inspectors had done their duties.
 - (b) Prescribe the post-entry quarantine stations and quarantine stations in which planting materials have to be detained and inspected .

CHAPTER V

Undertaking the duties and responsibilities by the Inspector General and Inspectors

- 14. The Inspector General or Inspector may perform as follows after scrutinizing the imported plant, plant product, non-plant product, pest, beneficial organism, soil are being in entry points:
 - (a) being seizing and destroying or being payment of fine for plant, plant product, pest, beneficial organism, soil which are imported without import permit.
 - (b) being disinfestation or disinfection for the plant and plant products imported with import permit or if it is not applicable , being send it back to the country of origin .
 - (c) notifying to the customs department to release the non-plant materials which are associated with post or soil after disinfestation or disinfection treatments had done.

- 15. Inspector General himself and Inspectors shall make records of actions taken in accordance with this Law.
- 16. Inspectors shall report to the Inspector General for every action taken in accordance with the Law.

CHAPTER VI

Undertaking the duties and responsibilities by State/Division/District/ Township officers-in-charge

- 17. The officers-in-charge of the State/Division/District/Township himself or any staff not lower than the deputy supervisor accredited on the absence of inspector shall inspect restricted or prohibited plant, plant product, non-plant product, pest, beneficial organism, soil, etc to void such things are trespassing their accredited territories.
- 18. Actions taken under clause 15 shall have to be reported to the Managing Director and a copy of report shall has to be send to the Inspector General .
- 19. Inspection of imported articles prescribed by the Law shall have to be done immediately and if the programmes to prevent entering and spread of pest have not yet presribed before , it has to be done so at the time of inspection . The consignment shall has to be obtained under the customs department until Inspector General or Inspector had approved the fulfillment of such requirements .

CHAPTER VII

Miscellaneous

- 20. A person who has been fined as administrative penality must deposit the fine payable to the account opened at the bank in the respective township and a copy of chalan has to be send to the Inspector General or Inspector.
- 21. Plants and plant products entering as packing materials shall have to be prohibited . This prohibition will not concern for timbers of plant origin Excelsior and Wood's wool, sterilized peat or Sphagnum moss, Osmunda fibre, Vermiculate, Wood shavings, Paper Pulp which are used as packing materials .
- 22. In accordance with the Plant Pest Quarantine regulation , fees for the services offered by the Myanma Agriculture Service, validity of the certificates shall have to be prescribed as follows:-
 - (a) For certificate of import for plant, plant product, non-plant product, pest, beneficial organism, soil.

- 23. In respect with the imported consignments through the foreign mail service, the inspection has to be done in co-operation with the Myanma Posts and Telecommunications, the Customs department and the Myanma Agriculture Service .
- 24. The fees said in clause 23 shall not be related to the disinfection or disinfestation works carried out by the enterprenuers conducted the fumigation works for export commodities which are recognize by the Pesticide Registration Board.
