- **6. Description of content:** This Resolution restricts the importation of whole onion (*Allium cepa*) plants and parts thereof, including bulbs, from countries where the following pests exist:

Acrolepia assectella, Acrolepiopsis sapporensis, Agriotes lineatus, Agriotes sputator, Agrotis segetum, Autographa gamma, Brachycerus albidentatus, Brachycerus algirus, Delia antiqua, Delia platura, Dyspessa ulula, Mamestra brassicae, Neotoxoptera formosana, Spodoptera littoralis, Puccinia allii, Urocystis cepulae and Aphelenchoides fragariae.

Importation of the seed of this species will be permitted, subject to a risk analysis of each individual case.

The purpose of this Resolution is to protect the horticultural production of onion (*Allium cepa*) plants and parts thereof (including bulbs) from quarantine pests for Venezuela which could affect such production as a result of the importation into the country of living material of this horticultural species from countries where it is found and where it is affected by these pests.
