Language(s): . Number of pages: Description of content: APQA prohibits the import of pollen for pollination of Pomoideae, 6. Prunus genus and Rubus genus from the distributed regions (countries) of E. amylovora. This decision is based on detection of E. amylovora from apple pollen for pollination imported to Rep. of Korea. Therefore, the import of pollen of host plants from the regions specified as above will be prohibited, shipped on and after 14 April 2020. 7. Objective and rationale: [] food safety, [] animal health, [X] plant protection, [] protect humans from animal/plant pest or disease, [] protect territory from other damage from pests. 8. Nature of the urgent problem(s) and reason for urgent action: Erwinia amylovora is a prohibited quarantine pest of Rep. of Korea. Therefore, the import of relevant parts of host plants of E. amylovora has been prohibited. In previous measures, the pollen was not considered as a pathway for E. amylovora. However, E. amylovora was detected from apple pollen for pollination during import inspection by APOA. Accordingly, emergency measures are enforced to prevent the introduction of *E. amylovora* through pollen for
